

Sermon Questions for Community Groups

Sermon: Fellowship Sunday

Date: April 30, 2017

Scripture:

1. "Licking the earth" - earthly pleasures that don't satisfy the soul. What earthly pleasures are currently distracting you from truly soul satisfying pleasures found only in Christ?
2. What is your greatest passion in life? What are you willing to give your lives to?
3. Am I equally passionate about things that matter to God?
4. Do you rejoice in your suffering or do you complain about it? Why?
5. The Church is the extension of God's kingdom and he allows us to be part of it. Do you approach the local church like it is a privilege for you to be part of it? Why?
6. It is the Church that calls us - everyone of us - into ministry and gives us the gifts to serve with. How has God gifted you? How are you currently deploying them in the service of the church?
7. If we speak about Jesus in a general way, most people will accept or tolerate us. But if we speak about our church, our beliefs, our Lord, obedience to Christ who is the head of the Church, not too many people are accepting. Do you water down what you share with others so you will be accepted or to avoid any conflict?
8. How is truth found in Colossian 1:27 - Christ in you, the hope of glory - encouraging to you?

9. Paul's big, hairy, audacious goal is that everyone would be perfect in Christ. No exceptions, no exclusions. Is Paul's goal our goal today? If so, how do we go about accomplishing it?

10. What will it take for you to be completely sold out for the local church? What does it look like for you to be completely sold out? What price will it cost you?

11. How are you purposely sharing the riches of Christ with those around you?
