Sermon Questions for Community Groups

Sermon: The Intervention of the God of Grace Series: Jonah (pt. 2) Date: Oct 1, 2017 Scripture: Jonah 1:3-17

- 1. What are some reasons why people run away from God? Have you found yourself running from God? What did you run to?
- 2. In what ways does God intervene in our lives? What is the primary way He intervenes?
- 3. There are two reasons God intervenes in our lives: 1) critical areas of our hearts resist God, and 2) unresolved sin gets worse over time. Explore examples of how these reasons play out in our lives.
- 4. What is the purpose of the storms in our lives? What storms has God brought you through? When you were brought to the other side of it, what had you learned about God? Yourself?
- 5. Are all storms in our lives a result of our sin? Why or why not?
- 6. What's God's motivation for intervening in our lives? How do you know that God is not against you?
- 7. The storm in your life is not there to pay you back from your sin, but to bring you back from you sin. Explain what you think this means?
- 8. What have you learned about God in this passage?
