Sermon: Revival and the God of Grace

Series: Jonah (pt. 7)

Date: Nov 5, 2017

Scripture: Jonah 3:1-10

1. Do you ever think that there must be more to life than what you are currently experiencing?
2. Why does no one talk about repentance anymore? What is your reaction to the word?
3. Because no one talks about repentance anymore, we have lost the proper definition for it. What does it mean to repent?
4. Do you struggle with guilt?
5. What is the difference between false and true guilt? Why is it important to know the difference?
6. How did the Ninevites repent? What can we learn from their example?
7. In 2 Corinthians 7, Paul writes about two types of sorrow - one being godly and the other being worldly. Can you explain the difference between the two? Which sorrow do you often experience in regards to your sin?
8. "If you want to know true revival it would be good to take a day to fast, to search your heart, and confess your sins. Write them down on a piece of paper. Be specific." What is your hearts response to this application? Have you done it? Why?
9. Thomas Watson wrote, "Trust not a passionate resolution; it is raised in a storm and will die in a calm." What is Watson saying? How have you experienced this in your own life?
10. AW Tozer wrote, "Make restitution wherever possible. If you owe a debt, pay it, or at least have a frank understanding with your creditor about your intention to pay, so your honesty will be above question. If you have quarreled with anyone, go as far as you can in an effort to achieve reconciliation. As fully as possible, make the crooked things straight." What actions do you need to take to turn your back on sin?
11. How did God respond to the Ninevites' repentance? Will He do the same for us? How does that make you want to respond?
12. Do you truly want revival in your life? What are you willing to do to get more of God?
