Sermon: What Should I Say? Part 3 – Talk about Jesus

Date: Jan 21, 2018

Scripture: John 14:6; Romans 5:8-11; Ephesians 2:4-6

1. How did God speak to you through the sermon on Sunday?
2. What do you say to someone when they ask you, “Who is Jesus?”
3. There are two common issues that often hold us back from sharing Jesus with others: lack of knowledge and the presence of fear. Which one is holding you back?
4. What has Jesus done for you?
5. “We don’t want to just simply win an argument or change our friend’s point of view. We want to create a safe environment that allows them to open up so that we can introduce them to Jesus.” How can we create safe environments for non-believers to talk about Jesus with us?
6. “Our job as Christians is to help remove barriers so people can see Jesus as the truth they need in their life.” How do we go about removing barriers to faith?
7. Who is someone in your life right now that you need to talk to about Jesus?
