1. How did God speak to you through the sermon on Sunday?
2. "A great deal of our present trouble in living out the Christian life stems from the fact that we do not keep our eyes fixed on the finish line." What is the finish line for the Christian?
3. In the way you live your life - decisions you make, attitude you hold, the things that concern you most - what alternative finish line is your heart secretly yearning for or striving towards? (E.g. retirement, financial freedom, having kids/kids leaving the house, etc)
4. What do verses 9-11 in Daniel 7 tell us about who God is (His nature)?
5. Is the answer to evil and suffering in this text satisfying? Why?
6. Who is the Son of Man and why is His identity significant in redemptive history? Significant for us today?
7. Do you find yourself overwhelmed by the state of the world and your own life? How can we find comfort from this text in God's Word?
